The 2004 Pascal, Cayley and Fermat competitions are in the books! I believe that they were a great success. Averages for both the Pascal and Cayley contests were up about 4 points to 87.2 and 92.6 respectively, while the Fermat average was down slightly to 83.9. There were 18 perfect scores on the Pascal, 6 on the Cayley, and 6 on the Fermat.

There was a mistake made in the setting of the Pascal contest. A small discrepancy in wording between the English and French versions of question 20 resulted in 6, answer B, being correct for the French version, and 5, answer C, being correct in the English version. In scoring the contest we accepted either B or C as correct. I apologize for this error.

Thank you to all participants, both teachers and students. I hope that the papers provided some entertainment for you, and that you will continue to support our efforts as we continue to try to support yours.

L'édition 2004 des concours Pascal, Cayley et Fermat est chose du passé! Et j'estime qu'il s'est agi d'un franc succès. Les moyennes des concours Pascal et Cayley étaient supérieures d'environ 4 points, soit 87,2 et 92,6 respectivement, tandis que celle du concours Fermat était légèrement à la baisse, soit 83,9. On compte 18 notes parfaites pour le concours Pascal, 6 pour le concours Cayley et 6 pour le concours Fermat.

Une erreur a été commise lors de la préparation du concours Pascal. En raison d'une légère différence entre les formulations anglaise et française de la question 20, la bonne réponse pour la version française était 6 (réponse B) alors qu'elle était 5 (réponse C) pour la version anglaise. Nous avons accepté ces deux réponses. Toutes mes excuses pour cette erreur.

Je remercie tous les participants, tant les professeurs que les étudiants. J'espère que les concours vous ont divertis et que vous continuerez d'appuyer nos efforts. De notre côté, nous nous emploierons à appuyer les vôtres.
